

### Questions & Updates

**Continuing Care Sites:** 38 centres now have CCS approvals for PREVAIL— about half of the sites we approached. This should make transfers and data collection smoother as it relieves some of the need for recruiting sites to continue to collect follow-up data remotely after a baby is transferred.

The process for granting clinical trials approvals has changed from the old IRAS/CSP system to a new system of HRA approvals. This will affect the process for gaining NHS permissions for the remaining 35-40 sites that we hope will participate as PREVAIL CCS but we are in discussion with the HRA about how to take things forward.

**Data Management:** A reminder from Zoe about Form 1—Eligibility:

- The date on Form 1 should be the date that you assessed eligibility for that patient, not the date that the form was completed (if the form is completed retrospectively)
