Top Questions

If a baby is on fungal prophylaxis but a dose is given only every 3 days (e.g. fluconazole) then how do you complete Form 4?

- Please tick yes to "were IV or enteral antifungals given?" for the duration of the course/while the treatment is active on baby's kardex or treatment plan, even on days where a dose is not given.

Do line tips from lines other than the intervention line (e.g. other PICCs, CVCs, UVCs) need to be cultured and recorded on Form 5?

- No, only blood, CSF and trial PICC line tip cultures should be recorded on Form 5, even if you have cultured another line tip as part of standard practice.

Amendments & Changes

Continuing Care Sites: The CCS agreements have not yet been set-up. For babies transferred to non-recruiting centres please do not send a transfer pack, as we cannot collect information from CCS without an agreement. It will remain the responsibility of the recruiting site to collect any follow-up information about transferred babies using BADGER or by calling the site. Apologies for any inconvenience; letters have been sent to most identified sites and we are working to get agreements set up ASAP.

Amendments: An amendment to the protocol and the PISC is ready for submission. We will let you know when this is approved by the ethics committee.

Materials: The poster, stickers, cot cards & certificates have been approved by ethics and are with your R&D departments. If no response is received within 30 days we can assume they are happy with the documents and we will begin sending them to sites.
